

2006 La Crosse Interstate Fair Junior Livestock Schedule

Wednesday, July 12: All livestock entries must be in place by noon on Wednesday.

Livestock Check-In and Market Animal Weigh-In on Wednesday is as follows:

- Market Lamb Weigh-In: 10:00am -1:00pm
- Market Hog Weigh-In: Wednesday Noon - 4:00pm or
Tuesday, July 11 from 7:00pm – 9:00pm (this date/time is tentative)
- Market Steer Weigh-In: Wednesday 5:30pm-7:00pm
- Beef breeding stock check-in begins at 1:00 on Wednesday
- Please note: ultrasound evaluation will **not** be done in 2006

Thursday, July 13

- Junior Beef Show: 8:30am (followed by the Open Class Beef Show)
- Junior Swine Show: 10:00am

Friday, July 14

- Junior Sheep Show: 8:30am
- Junior Livestock Auction Deadline: 5:00pm (any exhibitor with more than one animal selected for the auction must declare, to the Junior Livestock Committee before 5:00pm on Friday, which animal is to be sold in the auction)

Saturday, July 15

- If the exhibitor cannot be present to sell his/her animal in the auction, the exhibitor must submit a written excuse to the Junior Livestock Committee officers by noon on Saturday. The written excuse must identify another exhibitor to sell the animal.
- Junior Livestock Auction Set-up: immediately following conclusion of open class dairy show; an announcement will be made on the public address system; exhibitors and families are expected to assist with auction set-up.
- Junior Livestock Auction: 7:00pm
- Junior Livestock Auction Tear-down: immediately following the conclusion of the auction; exhibitors and families are expected to assist with auction tear-down
- Exhibitors must continue to feed/water auction animals until shipped to market!

Sunday, July 16

- Shipment of Non-auction Animals (**this is new for 2006!**): for a \$10 fee per animal, the Junior Livestock Committee will arrange for shipping of non-auction animals to local meat processing plants or to Equity Livestock; exhibitors and/or family members must notify the Junior Livestock Committee which non-auction animals will be trucked by the Committee and pay the trucking fees no later than noon on Sunday
- Round Robin Showmanship: 4:00pm
- Shipment of Auction Animals: Many (but not all) auction steers are shipped to market at 5:00pm on Sunday; exhibitor and/or family members are expected to assist with loading these animals.
- Release of all livestock: 6:00pm

Monday, July 17

- Shipment of all remaining auction animals and designated non-auction animals begins at 6:00am; exhibitors and/or family members are **not** required to be present.

- Livestock barn clean-up beginning at approximately 6:00pm; exhibitors and family members are expected to assist

Tuesday, July 18

- Carcass evaluation and educational session; time and place to be announced; attendance at this educational session counts toward completion of 2007 junior livestock auction educational requirements!

Times listed above are subject to change, please confirm times with beef, swine or sheep superintendents. Flyers with dates/times will be posted in the livestock barns.

Please note: livestock exhibitors must have their livestock exhibits and barns clean and orderly by 9:00am each day of the fair.
