For the cost of **\$20 each Participant** (4-H Participant \$15) the 5 sessions include: safety session, insurance, use of shotguns (if needed), ear protection, all ammunition, clay pigeons and facility use.



Youth will also be eligible for additional tournaments in the summer. This program is sponsored by the Friends of the NRA and La Crosse County 4-H Leaders Association.
