Assist with 4-H event logistics

- * Welcome participants to 4-H events (Pump House, Clover College, etc.)
- * Emcee events: Achievement Night, Drama/Arts Festival, Speaking and Demonstration Festival, Music Festival
- * Usher at events
- * Present awards and ribbons at events (Softball Tournaments, Fair)
- * Clerk at Fair
- * And others as specified by advisors
